Old Business:

Online MTS Clothing Store: Store was reopened and closed again on Friday. Will talk about profits at January meeting.

Movie Night: The DVD is here however the school doesn't have a DVD port so it will be streamed instead and the DVD will still be raffled out to a family. Staff will set up the gym with a few rows of blue mats and some chairs behind it. Aura will take donations at the door.

Jay will print out 12 posters with the 50/50 raffle and will also have a table set up with a laptop for anyone who wishes to buy a ticket. Raffle is set up for \$20,000 max and is sitting at \$500 right now.

Munch a Lunch: There was a discrepancy with Chopped Leaf but everything was worked out in the end. Melissa Lang has offered to send out an email to remind parents of a new menu which we excitedly accepted. There is a glitch in the Munch-a-Lunch system where it submits orders that have not been paid for. In the past we put them through and pay them however in the New Year there will be a generic email sent out saying that unpaid orders are not submitted. Discount Cards: We sold 6 cards in total and don't feel the effort was worth the outcome.

New Business:

Alberta School Council Engagement Grant: We have a total of \$682 to spend this year (\$182 left over from last year's \$500 and a new \$500 this year). These funds need to be used within certain parameters such as workshops, info sessions, trainers, etc. This year we will look into doing a healthy snack workshop to help teach parents how to prepare and pack healthy options in their children's lunch. We will also think of other ideas for the next few months.
